

Full steam ahead for the CINAGE project

In April 2015 Ljubljana, Slovenia, hosted the 4th CINAGE partner meeting at **The University of the Third Age**. The main focus was to prepare for the release of the final CINAGE package and to reflect upon Pilot Actions conducted over the last 5 months. Partners presented their experiences and concluded that high levels of volunteer motivation and commitment to their projects - and the pilot as a whole - proved to be a spectacular success. Special attention was drawn to the effectiveness of the diverse intergenerational learning opportunities in the pilot which really connected with volunteers. Additionally all partners highlighted the exceptional success of the cinema workshops which volunteers praised for their ambition and scope.

Finally the CINAGE partners approved the plan for a CINAGE Conference and Film Festival in Leeds in July 2015. There will be a short film competition with prizes available, a premier screening for the 12 CINAGE partner short films and special gala screenings of a feature selected by CINAGE Focus Groups, which includes active ageing narratives and competencies.

The 12 volunteer CINAGE films are nearly complete!

Earlier this year the CINAGE partners began production of their original short films and bringing volunteer scripts to life. With CINAGE volunteers taking lead production roles, the last several months have been a truly magical time and the films have all but been completed. Now in post-production the films range from social realism to melodramatic horror, from comedy to the daily experience of life.

- A Final CINAGE Flyer (available in all partner languages)


